NEW RESIDUAL WASTE CALENDAR

As of August 5th 2024, collection will be carried out by a new company and the pick-up days will change. As such the municipality will be divided into 2 sectors, north and south. The new collection schedule is attached. You can also pick up a copy at our offices and the calendar will also be posted on our website.

HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

Disposal of household hazardous waste (paint, varnish and solvents, used motor oil, aerosols, oxidants, alkaline and rechargeable batteries) is now by appointment only. Simply call 450-226-3117 to make an appointment. An attendant will accompany you when you drop off your household hazardous waste. It is important not to dispose of HHW in the rubbish bins. We have changed the location of this collection because the previous site was too close to the lake, and thus harmful to the environment. The new location is behind the Municipal Hall, but you cannot go there alone. Thank you for your cooperation.

PARKING IN VILLAGE SPECIAL AUTHORIZATION TRI-LAKE

The annual Tri-Lake regatta organised by SILFC will be held on 7 August. This event will bring together swimmers from three lakes. Visitors will be able to park at the north marina if spaces are available. All other parking lots in the municipality will also be available to visitors. The event will run from 9:00 to 15:00. We thank you for your understanding and hope that this decision will not cause you too much inconvenience.

PARKING PERMIT

A number of residents have not obtained their 2024 parking sticker.

We would like to remind you of the importance of complying with this regulation.

By-law 2023-03 was adopted to improve parking conditions at municipal marinas.

Article 10 Authorized vehicles: During the summer period, between 15 June and 15 September: Only vehicles bearing a parking sticker issued by the municipality are

authorized to park in the municipal marinas to the north and south, subject to the conditions specified in this by-law.

Article 13 Legal proceedings: Constitutes an offence and is liable to the stipulated fines:

- Any vehicle prohibited under section 11 of this by-law;
- Any vehicle parked without the vignette legibly displayed;

Any false declaration in order to obtain a parking sticker.

Article 14 Penalties

Anyone who contravenes this by-law is liable to a fine of \$200 plus costs for an individual and a fine of \$400 plus costs for a legal entity.

Any repeat offence is punishable by a fine of \$300 plus costs, for an individual, and a fine of \$500 plus costs, for a legal entity.

The municipal officer is responsible for enforcing this by-law.

Please come to the municipal office to obtain your stickers.

**NEW SIGNAGE
PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK
30 KM**

After several attempts with the Ministère des Transports du Québec, the municipality has finally obtained permission to lower the speed limit to 30km on part of Route 364, which runs through its territory. New signage will be installed from the village centre and beyond the pedestrian crossing. In addition, the municipality will be installing central markers and speed reduction bollards to create a safety corridor. You will see this new signage appearing in August, we have been promised by the Ministère. This initiative is a major element in ensuring the safety of all our citizens, young and old alike.
